

UCAS Clearing 2022 Applying Through Clearing

What is Clearing

Clearing matches applications to university places that are yet to be filled. It's available to anyone who has made a UCAS Undergraduate application and doesn't hold any offers. Clearing gives you a second chance to get your place at University.

You will be eligible for Clearing if....

- You are applying after 30th June 2022
- You are not holding any offers from Universities to Colleges you have applied to
- Your place is not confirmed after exam results are published.

How do you use Clearing?

The first place to start is to search for vacancies using [Search - UCAS](#)

1. After you have found the course you're interested in, give a call to make sure you meet the entry requirement and they still have vacancies.
2. If university offer you a place and you want to accept it, add the Clearing choice in [UCAS - Track](#).
3. If you are eligible for Clearing, in the "NEXT STEP" section, you will be given an options to "Add a Clearing Choice".
4. REMEMBER!!! You can apply for one choice at a time though Clearing. If you want to apply elsewhere once you have added a choice, then you need to ask that University to cancel your place so that you are able to apply again through Clearing.

What is Clearing Plus;-

Clearing Plus is personalise way for unplaced students to find a place through clearing. For the very first time, unplace students in Clearing can view a list of courses. They have personally been matched to in Track – alongside UCAS search tool which will still have 30.000 course options.

How does it work?

- If students find themselves unplaced, there are plenty of universities and colleges looking for applications. Now with Clearing Plus, finding right alternative course is much earlier.
- If application find themselves in Clearing, there will be a new button in TRACK called 'View Matches' you need to click this, start browsing courses they have been matched to, based on your application and the student providers have told UCAS they are looking for.
- If you find a course, you want to be considered for, you can click an 'I am interested button on your application and your details will be passes to the University/College.
- If the university or college still has places, they may contact the applicant to discuss things further and make an offer.
- If you receive an offer, all that is left to do is add it as a Clearing choice so your place can be confirmed.
