You must submit your work by the published deadline wherever possible. If, as a result of the EC, you are unable to meet the deadline, you must submit the work as close to published date as possible, at a time when you are satisfied with the work you have completed. Work with an approved EC that is submitted up to 6 working days after your original deadline will be considered as 'on time'.
